Please consider volunteering to lead one of the carnival stations. The leader is in charge of organizing the station, and the carnival co-ordinators will help you find volunteers and materials.

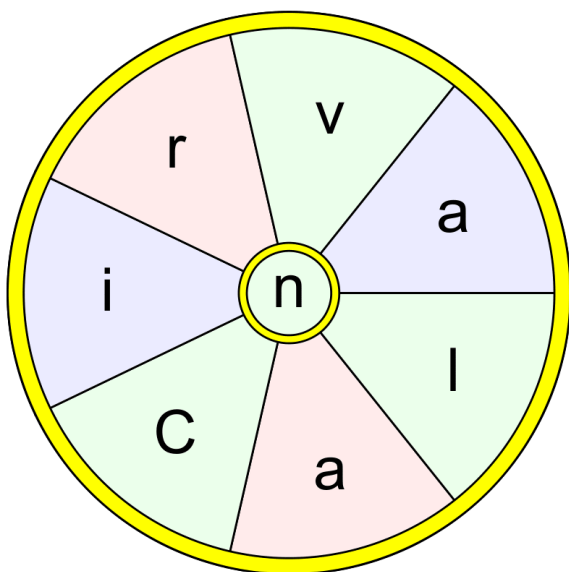


Stations you could lead:
